Exhibitors may arrive from 08.00 on the event day, access before this time is only by arrangement. There are no facilities for overnight parking or camping except by special arrangement. A map of the site will be sent to you with your entry pass. *If your exhibit is a road licensed vehicle you are welcome to join the gathering of steam engines in High Street Dartford at 12.00 noon on Sunday 13th May 2019 for the traditional tribute to Richard Trevithick and drive past of his place of burial. Alternatively join the static vehicle display in the pedestrian area of the High Street.*
Declaration: I declare that during the Event my exhibit if self-propelled will be covered by the minimum insurance and regulatory requirements of the Road Traffic Act irrespective of whether my exhibit is licensed for use on the public highway or not and by a current Pressure Vessel Insurance Policy if appropriate. I further declare that the boiler of any steam plant entered carries a current Boiler Inspection certificate and that I will produce documentary evidence of such Insurance and Inspection if or when requested by the event Safety Officer. I also declare that the driver(s) hold a driving licence of the appropriate class and will produce it if requested by the Safety Officer.
I agree that if driven within the Park my vehicle will not exceed a walking pace.
If my exhibit / display is not self- propelled it will be covered by a Public Liability Policy and by a Pressure Vessel Policy and Inspection certificate if appropriate.
I also agree to operate my exhibit during the event, comply with the instructions of the stewards and pay proper attention to the safety rules and regulations in accordance with the Code of Practice of the National Traction Engine Trust. In the event of a dispute the Event Organiser's decision is final.
